The contents and details of this covenant unfolded and was actualized in 2 Samuel. 9:1 when years after, David asked, "is there still anyone who is left in the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?" Covenants carry weight and their terms are often honoured for the good of all parties involved. Hence, it was uppermost in the mind of David to enforce it at the appointed time in the life of Mephibosheth. Covenants speak volumes and if there is anything we want to gloss over or toy within this life, covenants should not be it.

By committing ourselves to God through covenant, we invite His presence, guidance, and provision into every aspect of our lives. Psalm 25:14 assures us, "The LORD confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them." Through our reverence and obedience, we become recipients of God's intimate revelations and blessings.
